## **Remote Desktop (Windows)**

- To set up the Remote Desktop, start with the host computer, which in this example is your work computer.
- > First, you will need to know the name of your work computer.
  - On your work PC desktop, right click on "Computer" and select "Properties".

- Close the "Computer" dialog box.

- Click "Connect".
- When the "Log on to Windows" dialog box appears, type your username, password, and then click "Ok".
- > To end your Remote Desktop session:
  - Click "Start or rand then click "Log Off" at the bottom of the "Start Menu".
  - When prompted, click "Log Off".
